

# Learning Support Volunteer

AllSet Learning is looking for responsible, motivated and friendly volunteers to lead elementary students at our *Learning and Homework Support Program* in Central Richmond. Our *Learning and Homework Support Program* is dedicated to help elementary students, grades 4 through 7, improve their grades by assisting with their homework assignments and providing additional resources to improve English vocabulary, reading, writing, listening and mathematic skills.

We want to achieve a 1:1 student to volunteer ratio. Volunteers will work with the students for a total of 1.5 hours, starting at 4:00pm. After students leave the program at 5:30PM, volunteers and the head coordinator will conclude with a debriefing session of up to 30 minutes. During the debriefing, we will discuss and make detailed records of each student's progress and talk about ways to improve the program to further support our students' learning.

### Responsibilities

- Arrive in a timely manner to every session before students arrive at 4:00pm
- Support designated student(s) with completing their homework assignments and projects
- Upon completion of homework assignments, volunteers will support student's learning of additional educational materials
  - Additional educational materials (vocabulary, books, reading, writing, listening, mathematics) will be provided by AllSet Learning
- In the last 10 to 15 minutes of the session, volunteers may provide fun and educational group activities to students with good behaviour who have completed their homework assignments and educational materials
- Observe and take notes of learning progress and areas of improvement of designated student(s)
- Volunteers who have been selected to be part of the program must attend an orientation workshop prior to the start of the program

- Must be in Grade 10, 11, or 12
- · Responsible, organized and detail-oriented
- Self-motivated and able to work independently
- Friendly and sociable
- Patient and easy-going
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in English
- Most recent report card grades are required for review
- Experience working with children is preferred but not required
